N Solar Inc. Selects County of Sacramento for North American Headquarters and Manufacturing Facility

Sacramento, Calif., February 5, 2010—The Sacramento Area Commerce and Trade Organization (SACTO), the County of Sacramento, and McClellan Business Park jointly announced today that N Solar Inc., a newly incorporated U.S. company that is a subsidiary of Millinet, an IT equipment manufacturer, business services provider, and solar cell manufacturer based in Seoul, Korea, has chosen the County of Sacramento for its first North American facility. N Solar Inc. recently signed a lease with McClellan Business Park for 128,000 square feet of industrial space at 5207 Luce Avenue and will begin operations in September 2010, ultimately bringing 150 new jobs to the region.

N Solar Inc. will have both its headquarters and solar module manufacturing operations based at McClellan Business Park. The Sacramento Region was chosen for its proximity to state government entities, accessibility to solar partners and programs, relatively low cost of operations, and business-friendly environment. McClellan Business Park is a Local Agency Military Base Recovery Area (LAMBRA), which also allows N Solar Inc. access to the benefits associated with a LAMBRA.

Millinet Founder and N Solar Inc. President Sang Chul Lee stated “N Solar Inc. is very pleased to set up our operations in the County of Sacramento. We have had great

support from the State of California, the County of Sacramento, McClellan Business Park, and SACTO, and we look forward to cultivating these relationships for many years to come. We wish to thank everyone who has been involved for their partnership.”

“We are pleased to welcome N Solar Inc. to the Sacramento Region. The decision to locate its solar panel manufacturing facility in the Sacramento Region will have a significant impact on our regional economy and further solidifies the region’s emerging prominence as a clean energy technology hub—both on the national and international stage,” stated Jeanne Reaves, SACTO Chair.
